



Are you safe when using a ladder?



Use the correct ladder for the job.

- Non-conductive ladder near power lines or electrical equipment.

Inspect the ladder before each use.

Only one person should climb at a time.



When climbing down a ladder, look before you step off a ladder to obtain a sure, safe footing.

Use the correct angle, supports, treads, crossbrace and rails.

- Keep ladders free from slipping hazards and place on firm level surface.
- Use cross bracing on the rear of a step ladder for climbing only if it is designed for that purpose.

On this ladder the back rungs are designed for use.

Mark defective ladders and remove from service.
